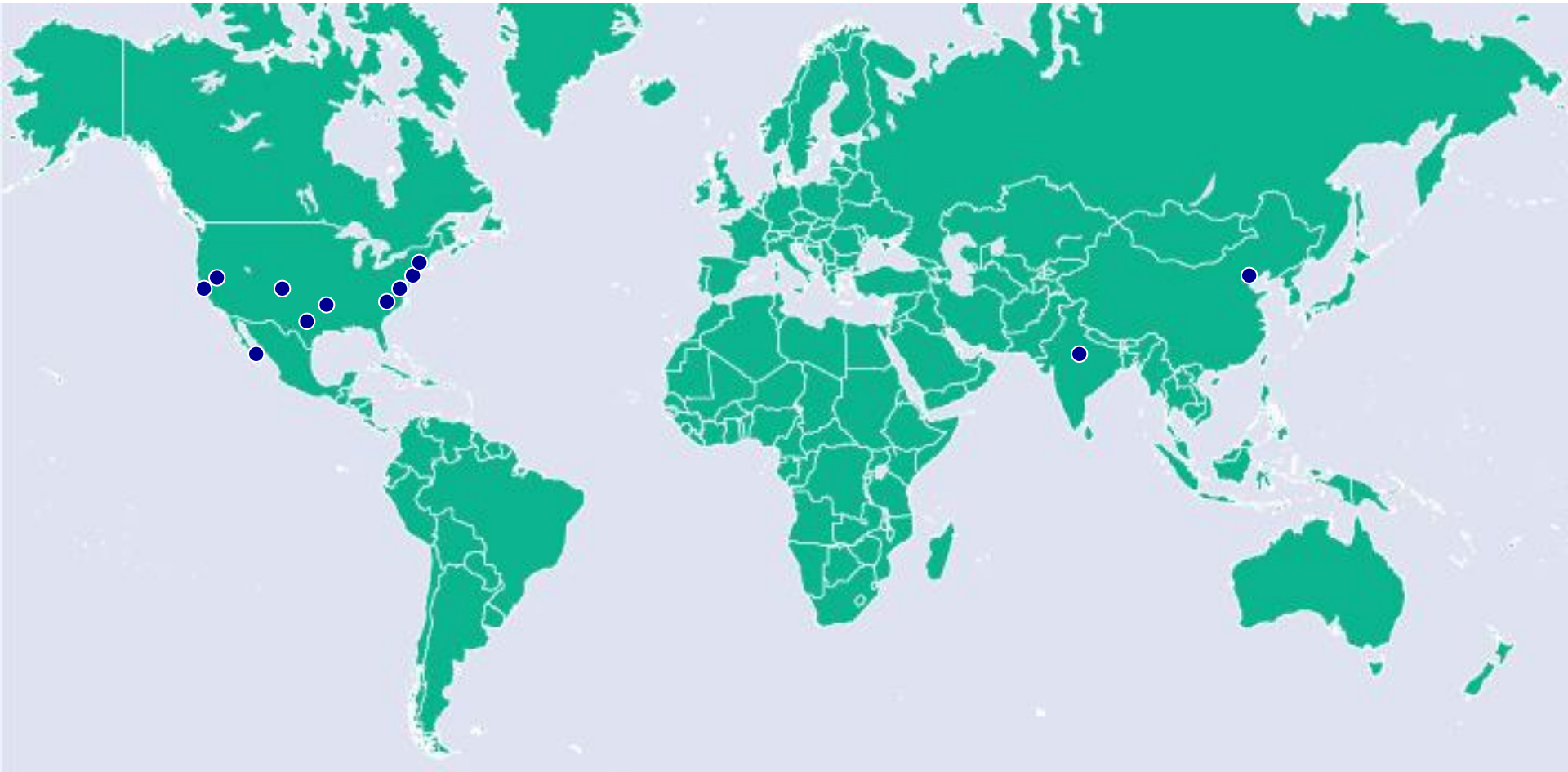

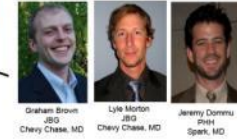
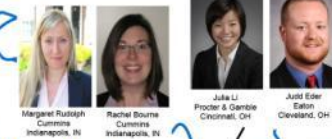

Outcomes to date

2008 - 2010 Outcomes

- Save **\$439 million in net operating costs** over the project lifetimes;
- Cut the equivalent of **958 million kilowatt hours of energy** use per year—enough to power 85,000 homes;
- Avoid over **557,000 metric tons of greenhouse gas** emissions per year—equivalent to taking more than 86,000 SUVs off the road.

2008 & 2009 Results

*Companies report that they are implementing upgrades representing **84% of the energy savings recommended by the fellows.***

2011 program details

Fellows

- Attends training in May
- Begins work in June
- Works full-time for 10-12 weeks
- Presents business case for energy efficiency

Companies

- Pay fellow's stipend & travel expenses
- Provide energy use information
- Sponsor & day-to-day manager
